### 2023 Football Frenzy

My brother knights, this year's football frenzy closed out with 3724 having sold 218 tickets. The estimated rebate to the council is \$1,962, and the 218 tickets sold exceeds the 100% per capital credit mark of 135 tickets. This gives us a break on our per capita tax to the state saving the council roughly \$500. Your efforts have raised \$4340 for the program overall. The program turn in closed on Dec 31, 2023, and 3724 has already had a couple of winners which is always gratifying. ### January Tidbits

January's full Wolf Moon reaches peak illumination on Thursday, January 25, 2024, at 5:39 P.M. EST. Look for the Moon to rise from the northeastern horizon around sunset that evening. It's thought that January's full Moon came to be known as the Wolf Moon because wolves were more likely to be heard howling at this time. It was traditionally believed that wolves howled due to hunger during winter, but we know today that wolves howl for different reasons. Howling and other wolf vocalizations are used to define territory, locate pack members, reinforce social bonds, and coordinate hunting.

The birthstone for January is the garnet, representing constancy. The word "garnet" comes from the 14th century Middle English word gernet, meaning "dark red." The word is derived from Latin granatum, which means "seed," and is called so because of the gemstone's resemblance to the beautiful red seeds of the pomegranate.

January's birth flowers are the carnation and the snowdrop. The carnation symbolizes admiration, remembrance and a mother's love. The snowdrop is used to express optimism, hope, compassion and innocence.

### January 1 - Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Holy Mother of God

Mary, Mother of God, mother of all, who bore and raised the Son of God, who sought to bring peace into the world. You treasured all you saw in your heart, as the fruit of your womb poured out love and mercy to each of us in our own personal way. Pray for us and be with us, that we may remember that we are also treasured in your heart. Help us to always remind others that they are just as treasured, that the world may know a true and just peace. Amen.

### January 7 - The Epiphany of the Lord

The kings of Tarshish and the Isles shall offer gifts; the kings of Arabia and Seba shall bring tribute. All kings shall pay Him homage, all nations shall serve Him.

### January 8 - The Baptism of the Lord

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth. O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations, Through Christ Our Lord, Amen.
