2025 Football Frenzy Summary

My Brother Knights, this year's football frenzy closed out with 313 tickets. That is the highest level of participation 3724 has ever had and on behalf of the Grand Knight thank you. The estimated rebate to the council is \$2,500, and the tickets sold exceed the 75% per capita credit mark of 254 tickets. This will give us a break somewhere around \$400 off our per capita tax to the state, overall returning roughly \$3,000 to the council.

The last 2 years have really shown the benefit this program can have for the council. This year will just be added to the example. 2023 was the first year since participation began that we sold enough tickets to qualify for a per capita credit.

MEMBERSHIP DIRECTOR'S CORNER

Where We Stand: Please welcome our newest member, John Snow. We now have 12 new brothers toward our fraternal year goal of 15. Brothers, you are doing an awesome job. Keep up the good work! We're on Third heading for Home!

Taking the First Step: Sometimes, the hardest thing about recruiting is taking the first step. Recruiting a new member can be as easy as asking him to join. Amazingly, many individuals haven't joined the Knights simply because they have never been asked to join. When the opportunity arrives, take the initiative and start a conversation with a potential prospect. It's the first step for recruiting on a one-on-one basis and can yield very positive results. Once a conversation begins, be confident that you will be able to answer their questions, no matter what direction the conversation will go. The Knights of Columbus, through its many programs and activities, assists individuals in so many ways that there is sure to be something that will appeal to anyone who wants to help his community, Church, or family. To ensure the best chances of recruiting a new member, refer to the checklist below. Make sure you ask all the pertinent questions while talking with the prospect, including:

- His complete name and address,
- Facts about his job,
- His parish affiliations and activities,
- Friends he has among present council members, and
Information on his wife and children.

All these facts can branch off into different areas: Knights of Columbus benefits, service projects, community involvement, or social events. Be prepared to answer any question he may ask to make your council look its best. You only get one chance to make a first impression, so make sure you have all the answers and necessary materials ready at your disposal:

- The Knights of Columbus Supreme, State, and Council 3724 websites, so he can learn more and join online.
- Facts on the Order's insurance program. Pick up a brochure in our Council's lobby to learn more about the Knights insurance program.
- A clear explanation of how membership has benefited you and your family; and
It may be good to also answer any questions his wife may have about the Knights of Columbus.

After making the pitch and answering any questions, ask the prospect to join and assist him in completing the "join process" online. The proposer should then follow through with the new member by either escorting him to his in-person exemplification ceremony or helping him complete the online exemplification 30-minute video. Finally, escort him to his first council meeting.

Recruiting on the personal level helps the potential member understand that you are not looking for numbers as much as you are looking for individuals like him. Let him know that he is not only wanted as a member, but that his membership can take all aspects of his life to new levels.

Don't forget to add www.kofc.org/join as an app to your cell phone. It's a lot easier to sign someone up and get information to him immediately. Remember, all online member applications with the Promo Code RHERNANDEZ (the code from our K of C Insurance Representative) will receive twelve months of online membership free. You can also use the promo code BLESSEDMCGIVNEY.

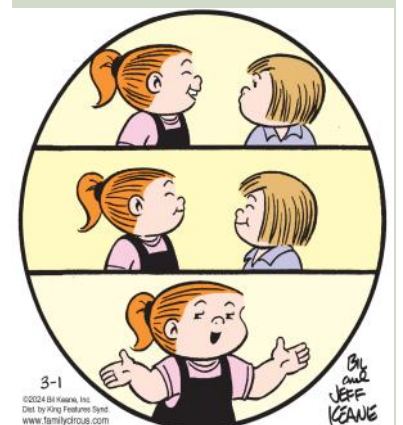

This Month in History of Council 3724

February 8, 1963 Article

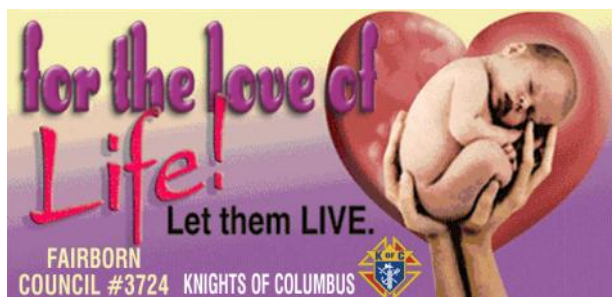

Council 3724 Supports Pro-Life



Council 3724 has a history of supporting Pro-Life initiatives. Recently the Council donated \$1000 to Carroll HS to support students traveling to DC to attend the 53rd March for Life. (see pictures on next 2 pages) The Theme for this year's March was "Life is a Gift". God gives life, nourishes life, and takes life. Reference the Catechism of the Catholic (CC) 2259-2262 for further *Respect For Human Life* teachings. The purpose of all marches (Wash DC and San Francisco) was to celebrate life.

Current Landscape: Great progress has been made since the Supreme Court overturned *Roe vs Wade*. While our local abortion center has yet to be shuttered, this has been a banner year for the preborn. Over 70 Planned Parenthood clinics closed in 2025, which is about 10% of their total clinics, primarily due to cuts in government funding (source: [Sarah Neely, Jan 23, 2026, Operation Rescue Press Release](#)). President Donald Trump signed the measure, prohibiting the use of federal tax monies to support abortion clinics for a year. Because of this, reproductive health groups like Planned Parenthood cannot get Medicare and Medicaid payments for a short time. A victory not only for the unborn, but for taxpayers who are opposed to having their tax dollars spent on killing the defenseless.

Currently, **21 states** have enacted significant pro-life protections (source: [Susan B. Anthony Pro-Life America](#)). In 2023, Ohioans (voters passed Issue 1 with 57% in favor vote) supported abortion rights by passage of an amendment to the State Constitution guaranteeing reproductive rights, including the right to abortion. But the Ohio Supreme Court, which underwent a significant change in the last election, will have the final say on how those rights will be interpreted.

In case you didn't know, 9 out of 10 Planned Parenthood facilities are located within walking distance of a college campus. Some universities even give college credit for internships at Planned Parenthood. Planned Parenthood is attempting to set the sex-ed curriculum of middle and high schools. They've recently pushed for "porn literacy in sex education" for young people (source: [Students for Life](#)).

Future Challenges:

Organizers noted that, while progress has been made, much remains to be done to implement God's Will. The Pro-Life movement's current focus is addressing the rise of **chemical abortion pills** (mifepristone), which now account for the majority (70%) of abortions in the U.S.

So, how can Council 3724 continue to be Pro-Life advocates:

Be vigilant when voting, vote for candidates who support God's pro-life mandates. Support the protection of the Hyde Amendment to keep taxpayers funded abortion out of national health care bills.
